1. Extending with your own functions.

You can always extend FrAid with your own FrAid functions. These are the steps required:

- Create a text file containing the FrAid definitions you want loaded.

Example file - myFun.frd

```
f(x) = if isNextIntEven(x) then 1 else -1;
```

- There are two ways to load them in FrAid
 - Using the -load command line parameter when you start FrAid.

Example

```
fraid.sh -load myFun.frd
```

- Using the load("filename") function.

Example - after you run FrAid

```
load("myFun.frd");
```
